This announcement no doubt comes as a disappointment to many of our students who have been working hard toward their exams. However, Cambridge International has committed to work with schools to provide grades for their students based on best available evidence. We will be communicating with our Cambridge regional administrators March 25th 2020 on the IGCSE and Checkpoint withdrawal process of all school and student candidates.

Further updates will include graduation amendments in light of no IGCSE's, and suggestions Cambridge are providing students as first time University entrants.
