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NATIONAL INVENTORS' DAY Project Information

Primary 1, 2, 3

Pick an inventor and create a display (model or mobile) to showcase the invention OR bring in a physical item.

Be as creative as you can!

The index card should include the following information on the lined side:

- The inventor and the invention
- A fun fact about the inventor or invention
- What is the use of the invention?
- How has this invention helped your life?

*Bonus points for project in students handwriting.

Primary 4, 5, 6

In the past 10 years, how has technology or artificial intelligence (AI) improved an invention in the following: transportation, communication, medicine, sports, or school/learning?

1. Pick an item (invention) that has changed over time in one of the areas above and explain the following on the lined side of your index card:
 - The topic chosen and invention
 - Name the original inventor of the item before it changed
 - The use of the current invention
 - How has the invention helped/changed your life
2. Showcase what you learned in one or more of the following ways:
 - Physical display (trifold board, poster board, etc.)
 - Digital display (PowerPoint or another program)
 - Physical item

Note: You will also be asked to talk about your invention, the use of it, and how it betters your life. This will take place on Monday, February 9th. Oral presentations will be taken into consideration when selecting our winners.

OPEN TO ALL: YOU ALSO HAVE THE OPTION OF CREATING YOUR OWN INVENTION AND SHOWCASING IT!

On the lined side of your index card include: the name of the invention, the use of it, and how the invention can help us in life. A display of the invention must be included.
